
How to do your wildfire hazard clean

ossland properties near the forested edge of town face the greatest wildfire risk but embers from wildfires can land further inside and ignite fires in vegetation and accumulated debris which can spread to your house. Follow these FireSmart Tips to reduce the wildfire hazard on your property.



A surface fire can climb up into trees quickly. On coniferous trees remove all branches to a height of 2 metres from the ground within 30 metres of your home.

Prune branches close to the tree trunk but not so close that you damage the main trunk and bark of the tree. Never remove more than 1/3 of the canopy of the tree.



Coniferous trees (evergreens with cones and needles) are highly flammable and should not be within 10 metres of your home.

Cedar hedges and juniper bushes are especially flammable – Removing these is a priority...

Deciduous (leafy) trees are resistant to wildfire and are a good FireSmart choice for planting within 10 metres of your home.

Branches, stems and yard debris will be collected starting April 29... (1 pickup truck load/property max)

Please help by ensuring:

- -No stems thicker than 10 centimetres (4 inches)
- -No pieces longer than 3 metres (10 feet)
- -Yard debris is not left on street or sidewalk
- -VEGETATION ONLY no building materials or junk
- -No invasive species vegetation... More info at ckiss.ca
